

Regarding the EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR)

We hope this letter finds you well. We sincerely appreciate your continued support and business.

With regard to the EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR: Regulation (EU) 2025/40), the restrictions on the use of hazardous substances in packaging under Article 5 came into effect on August 12, 2026.

Accordingly, we would like to inform you of the results of our assessment and our response policy, as outlined below.

Details

1. Applicable Regulation

Regulation: EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR: Regulation (EU) 2025/40)

Application date: August 12, 2026 (Article 5: Restrictions on the use of hazardous substances in packaging)

Scope: Packaging materials used for products shipped to the European Union, as well as all items that serve packaging functions, including but not limited to product protection, handling, and delivery.

Requirement: The total concentration of lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium shall not exceed 100 mg/kg.

2. Results of Our Assessment

We have confirmed that the combined concentration of lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium in the packaging materials used for our shipments to the European Union does not exceed 100 mg/kg.

3. Future Response

Although the PPWR provides for multiple requirements in addition to those described above, we will continue to monitor applicable deadlines, related regulations, and official guidance, and will implement any necessary measures as required.
